Application Rules

1. Local artists only –must be a Fayette County Resident.
2. Only one application/submission per artist
3. Each logo must include “Fayette County, Ohio Bicentennial” and “1810-2010”
4. Maximum 3-color for printing purposes - if the artwork includes black, that must be considered as one of the colors
5. Application, logo submission, and copyright waiver Postmarked no later than midnight June 30th, 2009

7. **\$100 prize to winner sponsored by Merchants National Bank** (Winner chosen July 10, 2009)
8. Artwork should be submitted in paper form and CD, if chosen as the winner, the original artwork will need to be supplied for printing. Both the CD and the printed version of the logo must be clearly marked with Designer’s name, address and phone number. The following electronic formats will be accepted: jpeg, or pdf.
9. The artwork should be a design that would print well on a variety of mediums such as fabric, paper, glossy paper, plastics, and such.
10. The designs will be judged on their concepts more than on the technical skills of the designer. A winning design may be redrawn by a professional graphic artist at the discretion of the committee
11. If younger than 18 years of age, you must have a parent or guardian’s signature.
12. For judging purposes, your name or any other identifying item may not appear on the artwork submitted for the contest. Your name and/or signature of your artwork, should you win the logo contest, will appear on the logo when published.
13. The artist’s name SHOULD NOT APPEAR on the front side of the entry. Artists artwork should be signed with name, address, city, state, zip and phone number ON THE BACK of the artwork.
14. Artwork should be the artists’ original work. Artwork will be disqualified if it is plagiarized from another source, infringes on copyright laws, or otherwise misrepresented.
15. We will attempt to publish the artwork with credit given to the artist any time it is used, but do not guarantee that to be the case every time.

If submitted designs do not meet the criteria or are deemed by the judges not to achieve our goals, we reserve the right to continue the search for a new design by continuing this competition or by other means.
