INFORMATION

1. The parade will be held on Sunday, November 26th, and will start promptly at 3:00 p.m.
2. Parade theme is: **“Peace on Earth.”** There is no cost to enter.
3. Line up will be in the parking lot of Washington High School/Middle School. **Please enter on Willard Street**, unless instructed otherwise.
4. Entries will be permitted to line up at 1:00 p.m. Please be in place no later than 2:30pm.
5. WVNU Lite 97.5 will be judging the entries and sponsor the following awards: Most Original and Best Use of Theme.
6. Costumes for All Occasions is donating costumes to anyone in the parade. First come first served, contact Myckki Austin Harkleroad at 740.333.5400.
7. Parade place numbers and a full list of entries will be issued the week of the event and sent via email.
8. The parade will disband on Circle Avenue and McHenry Field.

PARADE RULES

1. No objects, including candy, fliers, or favors may be THROWN along the parade route. Anyone throwing objects into the crowd can be removed from the parade.
2. The Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to edit commentaries as needed for time.
3. Drivers of motorized vehicles must have a valid driver’s license.
4. For safety reasons, during the parade, please maintain a distance of two to three car lengths between units.
5. Fire code requires that a minimum 2A10BC fire extinguisher be carried on each float or in the float’s pull vehicle.
6. **Please do not include a Santa on your entry. The Chamber has contracted with Santa to appear, and having another Santa in the parade is in conflict with our contract.**
7. The Fayette County Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to remove any entry from the parade that it deems inappropriate.
